Credit for this course will be based upon these academic pieces and one's attendance and accomplishments on the job. The details of each internship will be worked out with the employer and the LCHS internship advisor. By the end of a student's senior year, every student must have earned at least 5 credits of internship to qualify for graduation. The work experience can also be done of the summer if coordinated with the internship advisor.

Integrating the elements and principles of design, students will produce works such as graphic design, digital imaging, photography, collage, fabric design, weaving, illustration, painting and printmaking. All students must take the AP Studio Art 2-D exam administered by the College Board at a cost of about \$90. This is not a written exam, but a portfolio submission of original works. This course is recommended for extremely motivated students desiring admission into the UC or CSU and will require much independent work outside of the classroom. It also meets the LCHS fine arts or elective graduation requirement. Prerequisite: Complete Art II with 80% average and receive a teacher recommendation.

AP Studio Art: Two Dimensional 2 **ART205**
Grades: 09 - 12 College Prep: Yes Credit: 5.000

UC Approved "f" course, students produce original 2-D works of art reflecting quality, a concentration on a visual interest or problem, and breadth of experience in the formal, technical and expressive means of the artist. Integrating the elements and principles of design, students will produce works such as graphic design, digital imaging, photography, collage, fabric design, weaving, illustration, painting and printmaking. All students must take the AP Studio Art 2-D exam administered by the College Board at a cost of about \$85. This is not a written exam, but a portfolio submission of original works. This course is recommended for extremely motivated students desiring admission into the UC or CSU and will require much independent work outside of the classroom. It also meets the LCHS fine arts or elective graduation requirement.

AP English Lang & Comp 1 **ENG224**

Grades: 11 - 12 College Prep: Yes Credit: 5.000

College level UC approved "b" course, students will read and critically analyze 17th - 21st century American literature. Students will demonstrate and develop their reading comprehension and critical analysis through expository, analytical, and argumentative assignments. All students taking this course must take the AP English Language and Composition exam in the spring at cost of about \$90. Depending on how well students score on the AP exam, colleges and universities may award them college credit for this course. This course is recommended for highly motivated students and those students desiring admission into the UC and CSU systems.

Prerequisite: Students must read and write at or above grade level and complete the AP summer reading. Teacher recommendation may be necessary.

AP English Lang & Comp 2 **ENG225**

Grades: 11 - 12 College Prep: Yes Credit: 5.000

College level UC approved "b" course, students will read and critically analyze 17th - 21st century American literature. Students will demonstrate and develop their reading comprehension and critical analysis through expository, analytical, and argumentative assignments. All students taking this course must take the AP English Language and Composition exam in the spring at cost of about \$90. Depending on how well students score on the AP exam, colleges and universities may award them college credit for this course. This course is recommended for highly motivated students and those students desiring admission into the UC and CSU systems.

Prerequisite: Students must read and write at or above grade level and complete the AP summer reading. Teacher recommendation may be necessary.

AP English Lit & Comp 1 **ENG222**

Grades: 11 - 12 College Prep: Yes Credit: 5.000

College level UC approved "b" course, students will read and critically analyze college-level prose, poetry, and drama from the 16th - 21st century. Students will demonstrate and develop their reading comprehension and critical analysis through expository, analytical, argumentative, and creative writing assignments. All students taking this course must take the AP English Literature and Composition exam in the spring at a cost of about \$90. Depending on how well students score on the AP exam, colleges and universities may award them college credit for this course. This course is recommended for highly motivated students and those students desiring admission into the UC and CSU systems.

Prerequisite: Students must read and write at or above grade level. Students must complete an AP summer reading project. A teacher recommendation may be necessary.

AP English Lit & Comp 2 **ENG223**

Grades: 11 - 12 College Prep: Yes Credit: 5.000
