Students will have multiple opportunities to use construct, question, model and interpret financial situations through algebraic, graphical, tabular and verbal representations, and create a portfolio for their financial well-being.

Financial Literacy Mathematics -2 MATH267

Credit: 5.000 Grades: 09 - 12 College Prep: Yes This is a UC approved "c" course.
